A SPECTACULAR SITE

The ‘Cœur de Vallée’ vineyard is situated in the world-renowned Oakville appellation, in the *heart* of the Napa Valley. The To Kalon Creek meanders through the spectacular property, which is planted to Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. The beautiful view of Mount Saint John is a reminder of the **alluvial fan** that provided the **well-draining soil**, comprised of **40 to 60% of gravel**. It is the confluence of the amazing pedigree of surrounding properties and the alluvial material originating from the Mayacamas Range that makes this vineyard so special. Handcrafted using classical winemaking techniques, this wine is named after its vineyard namesake. It is ‘Heart of the Valley’ or ‘Cœur de Vallée.’



THE 2018 VINTAGE

From spring to harvest, the weather in 2018 was remarkably steady and gentle, creating **ideal conditions for a superb vintage**, where great quality was paired with relative quantity. Beginning with a mild spring, a late bloom generated uniform grape clusters. Warm temperatures throughout the growing season (without any heat spells) led to a cooler than average ripening season, which allowed for an extended hang time during the ripening process. Riper flavors were noticeable at lower sugar levels. Élevage confirmed the strong personality of this **incredible and age-worthy wine**.

WINEMAKER NOTES

“The remarkable 2018 ‘Coeur de Vallée’ leaps from the glass with an **intense and complex bouquet** of black raspberries, crème de cassis, rose petals, dried tobacco, coffee bean and truffles. Full-bodied, seamless and opulent, the wine boasts a **powerful, yet weightless style and an amazingly long finish!**”
