


A First Great Growth in the heart of the Napa Valley



A SPECTACULAR SITE

The 'Cœur de Vallée' vineyard is situated in the world-renowned Oakville appellation, in the heart of the Napa Valley. A seasonal creek meanders through the spectacular property, which is planted to Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. The beautiful view of Mount Saint John is a reminder of the alluvial fan that provided the well-draining soil, comprised of 40 to 60% of gravel. It is the confluence of the amazing pedigree of surrounding properties and the alluvial material originating from the Mayacamas Range that makes this vineyard so special. Handcrafted using classical winemaking techniques, this wine is named after its vineyard namesake. It is 'Heart of the Valley' or 'Cœur de Vallée.'



THE 2020 VINTAGE

The 2020 season began with a warm and dry winter, as abundant rains did not come until the end of March. The mild spring season induced bud break sooner than had been originally expected, which led to the early ripening of the Cabernets. Bloom occurred under fair conditions, which led to a very good berry set. The summer season was typical, with its abundance of sunny and warm days alternated by cool nights and mornings. The vines and their crop developed normally. Due to the shortage of winter rains and the economic challenges caused by the pandemic, we decided to remove a considerable amount of fruit from the vines. This wise and conservative decision allowed an even earlier ripening and subsequent harvest (September 12-17), which permitted us to dodge the devastating Glass Fire (September 27th). The consistent warm temperatures without major heat spikes maintained the natural acidity, hence the fresh and lively character of this wonderful vintage.

WINEMAKER NOTES

"Boasting an intense and complex bouquet of crushed strawberry, cassis, blackberry, black cherry, fig leaf, mocha and tobacco leaf, the 2020 'Cœur de Vallée' is rich and concentrated, with a superb entry of red and black fruits, dark bittersweet chocolate, Kahlúa liqueur, dried lavender, potpourri and cedar cigar box. With round tannins and a creamy texture, this is a magnificent wine." *Luc Morlet*
