Morlet Family Vineyards is recognized internationally as a First Growth of California. Luc and Jodie Morlet handcraft *vins de terroir* and unique *cuvées* from their estate vineyards in Napa Valley as well as from the Sonoma Coast. Luc Morlet has achieved the remarkable feat of receiving the most 100 points across the varietals of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Sémillon-Sauvignon Blanc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Late Harvest Sémillon. The Morlet style results in wines which are harmonious in their intensity, richness, and complexity. It is this notion of harmony that inspired their logo, based upon 19th century French artist Mathurin Moreau's sculpture entitled, 'L'Harmonie.' The Morlet wines clearly display personality, seamless character, and graceful aging capability.



AN HISTORIC WINERY & ESTATE VINEYARDS

The historic estate is just north of the charming town of St. Helena. Luc and Jodie restored the Pre-Prohibition winery, built in 1880, into a gravity-flow winemaking facility. Within the prestigious St. Helena appellation, this Cabernet Sauvignon hillside vineyard supplies the premium fruit for the 'Morlet Estate' label. Luc and Jodie's Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard, from which the highly acclaimed 'Force de la Nature' 'Force Tranquille' & 'Cœur de Vallée' wines hail, is located in the world-renowned Oakville appellation. On the foothills facing the western slopes of Mount St. Helena, Luc and Jodie's Knights Valley vineyard provides the fruit for their 'Mon Chevalier' Cabernet Sauvignon. The warm and windy climate is ideal for the long ripening of the five red Bordeaux varietals. The Morlet's estate vineyards are meticulously farmed utilizing organic and regenerative practices which reflect the family's commitment to being great stewards of the land while remaining authentic toward each of their unique *terroirs*. In addition to their family-owned vineyards, they direct the farming under long-term contracts on vineyards located in the Russian River Valley and Fort Ross-Seaview on the Sonoma Coast.

AN UNWAVERING COMMITMENT TO QUALITY

Aged exclusively in French oak barrels from selected artisan coopers, the wines are bottled unfinned and unfiltered. An unwavering commitment to quality leads to small yields, attentive sorting, and the highest standard when blending. Thus, a very limited amount of each wine is ever produced.
